Journey to English (Intermediate Course), our intermediate course covers levels B1 and B2 (IELTS 4.5-5.5) and in October 23, the company will publish ***Journey 2 Advanced English (Advanced Course)*** covering C1 and C2 (IELTS 6- 9) to be launched in October 2023

Do not use Translation into The Mother Tongue

Translation teaches learn about language, but not how to use it. Translation does not help learners develop their communication skills. Translation encourages learners to use L1, often for long periods of class time, when the aim of modern teaching is to remove it from the classroom. The skills involved in translation are not suitable for all kinds of learners. It may, for example, be best for learners who are more analytical or have preferences for verbal-linguistic learning strategies. It is not suitable either for young learners or lower levels. Learners do not see the value of translation as an activity to help them learn English, and instead see it as a specialised, and difficult, activity. Translation is a difficult skill which must be done well in order to be productive and rewarding. Learners and teachers not only have to take into account meaning but also a range of other issues, including form, register, style, and idiom. This is not easy and too many translation activities therefore result in incomplete, inaccurate and sometimes unintentionally nonsensical language.
